

Food bank invites coast residents to ‘stuff the truck’

WARRENTON — Fred Meyer and Kraft, along with local event organizers Arbor Care Tree Specialists, New Northwest Broadcasters and Clatsop Community Action Regional Food Bank, will hold the 2008 “Stuff the Truck” annual food drive from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. Saturday at the Fred Meyer Warrenton store, 695 S. Highway 101.

Warrenton is the future home of the new CCA Regional Food Bank Distribution Center. Though the event will take place on one day, organizers say continuing efforts to donate and supply Clatsop County’s food bank with food from residents are vital.

From 10 a.m. to 2 p.m., NNB Radio’s five-station remote location will be set up by stations KAST-1370

AM, KAST-99.7 FM, KKEE-1230 AM, KCRX-102.3 FM and KVAS-103.9 FM.

At 11 a.m., county, city and business leaders will gather for photos as well as a presentation by Kraft on the topic of grant funds for the distribution center.

Representatives and volunteers from the CCA Regional Food Bank

will be on hand to answer questions and provide information about the emergency food needs of the residents of Clatsop County. All residents, organizations and businesses are welcome to participate in the food drive.

Fred Meyer and Kraft will donate \$30,000 toward the construction and equipment of a new food bank distribution center.
